

8th Grade Summer Math Project:
Part II: Math-O-Graphy

Guidelines:

Write an autobiography about your math experiences. It can be presented through any means - written in paragraphs, google slides, pamphlet, poster, prezi, etc. It should be written using complete sentences and correct grammar. There is no set length, but you should write until you have satisfied the requirements below and make sure your teacher will have a good understanding of who you are as a math learner. This project is due on the first day of school in September and will be a graded assignment.

Your writing should address ALL of the following:

- Give a summary of your experiences with math in elementary and middle school- good and bad.
- Consider what makes a great math teacher. Discuss what works well and what does not.
- What topic do you like learning about in math? What types of activities have you done in classes that have helped you learn that topic?
- Consider what topics you do not like about learning math. What types of activities have you done in classes that have not helped you learn math.
- What style of learning works best for you? Do you like working in groups, independently, online, on projects, etc. What doesn't work as well?
- What type of career do you think will be a good fit for you? How do you think that career uses math?
- Are you thinking about college as a next step after high school? Explain what you think you will be doing in 6 years.
